200 Riders Compete in Action-Packed AMSOIL Arenacross in Freedom Hall

LOUISVILLE, KY (January 13, 2014) – Powerful motorcycles will jump, fly and speed around Freedom Hall Saturday, January 18 and Sunday, January 19. AMSOIL Arenacross is returning, bringing nearly 100 professional riders and more than 100 amateur racers. Arenacross is the world's premier form of enclosed off-road motorcycle racing, providing captivating competition on one-of-a-kind, man-made dirt tracks.

Tickets for Saturday's 7 p.m. professional race are \$22 -\$32 for adult's reserved seating and \$6 for children's reserved seating (ages 2 -12). Sunday's amateur racing starts at 12 p.m. and tickets are \$11 for adult's general admission and \$6 for children's general admission. Ticket prices increase \$2 if purchased the day of the show. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle.

Fans can also attend a Saturday pre-race party on the Arenacross track. Attendees will have the opportunity to walk along the course, talk to riders and see the motorcycles up close. The pre-race track party is \$5 for both adults and children and goes from 5 p.m. – 6 p.m.
