TRAVELING TEAMS COMPETE IN UNDER ARMOUR GIRLS NATIONALS AT THE KENTUCKY EXPOSITION CENTER

LOUISVILLE, KY (June 29, 2015) – Girls' traveling all-star basketball teams from across the country will come to Louisville for the Under Armour Girls Nationals Monday, July 6 - Wednesday, July 8. The tournament has nearly doubled this year, with more than 140 teams competing in the North Wing and East Hall of the Kentucky Exposition Center.

Competitions run Monday 9:00 a.m. - 6:30 p.m., Tuesday and Wednesday 8:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Teams will compete in pool play before moving on to bracket competition.

Coaches from Division 1, 2, and 3, NAIA and junior colleges will attend this NCAA-certified tournament. Traveling teams are comprised of the best players from different schools and provide athletes the opportunity to showcase their skill sets for college coaches and recruiters.

Tickets are \$10 per person per day. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle

ABOUT PARKING

Conveniently located adjacent to the Louisville International Airport and near the junction of three major interstates, the Kentucky Exposition Center is easily accessible and just five minutes south of downtown Louisville. The spacious grounds have 19,000 parking spaces and is accessible from six gates surrounding the facility. Gates are located off of Phillips Lane, Crittenden Drive and Preston Highway. Parking at the Kentucky Exposition Center is \$8 per vehicle and \$20 per bus.
