



TRAFFIC ALERT

If you are driving Interstate 64 East to Louisville, be aware the Sherman Minton Bridge connecting Indiana to Kentucky is closed indefinitely. You will need to take a detour by following Interstate 265 East (Lee Hamilton Expressway) to Interstate 65 South which will bring you over the Ohio River to Louisville. If you approach the area on this route during morning or afternoon rush hours, be prepared for slowed traffic and long delays.

Other Possible Routes

From Evansville – If you are driving Interstate 64 East to Louisville, follow US-41 (Edward T. Pennyrile Parkway) to the Western Kentucky Parkway East to Interstate 65 North.

From Owensboro – Follow the William H Natcher Parkway South to the Western Kentucky Parkway East to Interstate 65.
